City of Houston Council member Larry Green came and discussed some issues around the neighborhood.

Speed Bumps – A few speed bumps are being installed around the neighborhood. If there are concern areas contact the city and they will send engineers to assess.

New establishments in the area. No news of what is coming in the Stella Link Strip. UT research facility coming to B/Speedway.

Att putting in fiber optic cable down Stella Link. If anything is damaged Att will repair/replace.

Bayou. Project Brays will reduce flooding issues. Flood control department will have further information.

24 hour hotline through SEAL. Woodshire no longer part of neighborhood security. Will increase security by reducing the number of homes. Has been an increase of breaking cases. Linkwood had 4 incidents in December, Woodside had 3 in January. If there are more dues we can increase SEAL hours. Need to harden targets around neighborhood, don't have things accessible and visible. Need to stop solicitors.
DRT team. Game Room in the strip stopped for now as they were disruptive. Sewage issue on Woodvalley. Owner is given 30 days to address the issue. Installing cameras at the front of neighborhood was not logistically possible.
