

**Woodside Civic Club (WCC) – February 21, 2018 General Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to Order

1. Security – Report given by Sharon who noted the crime rates are down. The instances of crime that we have had are mainly where vehicles have been rummaged through. She stressed the importance of keeping vehicles locked and keeping nothing of values in the car. An added notice was provided for our residents to call HPD for any issues of concern. HPD does keep track of the number of calls from each neighborhood and increased calls help to provide more coverage.
2. Chapter 19 Floodplain Ordinance – Bob spoke about this proposed ordinance but we will supplement any information we receive in the future.

4. Block captains – Marian reported on block captain participation and asked for volunteers. She also requested volunteers for Welcome Wagon and asked attendees to inform WCC when they know of new neighbors.
5. Woodside sign – Sharon reported on status of sign Stella Link / Latma sign repair.
6. BSN – Tom provided highlights from last week's BSN meeting
  - Stella Link cleanup
  - Groundbreaking for Linkwood park in August. Estimated August – Feb.
  - Buffalo Spdway and Stella Link bridge extension timing
  - Braes Bayou Greenway – improving Braes Bayou trail system
7. Dues Drive – Sharon reported that dues notices will go out in the next couple of weeks. It was stress that the majority of the WCC Dues covers our private SEAL Security which since we have employed them in Jan 2015, our crime rates have dropped. It's extremely important to maintain this private security which is only funded by our Woodside Civic Club dues. The remainder of our dues is spent on mosquito spraying, landscaping of our esplanade at Stella Link and Latma.

**New Business:**

1. Residents reported problems with sanitary sewer lines.
2. Resident reported frequent traffic accidents at Stella Link and Latma due to the light timing and signals.
